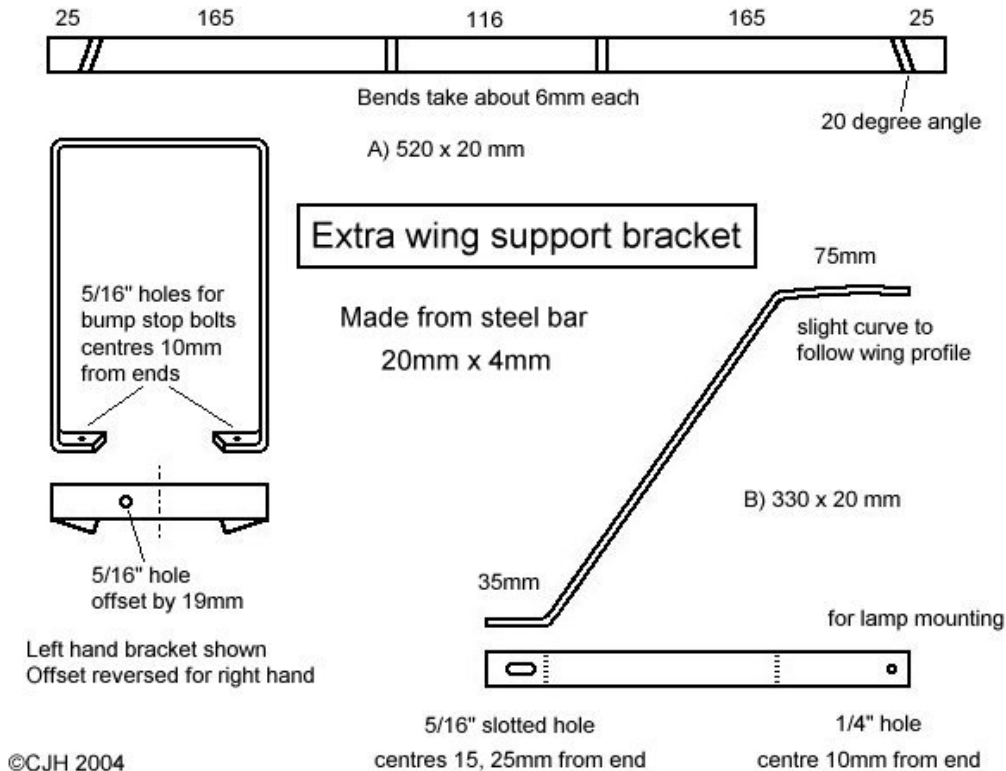


## Additional Wing Support Brackets

These additional support brackets are designed to improve the stiffness of the front wings. Although based on other designs, I have formed these without having to perform any welding.

The measurements given are those which I used but may, of course, be adjusted to suit. I used 20mm x 4mm steel bar which is readily available, for example, from B&Q stores.

Part A fits over the front upper wishbone and is fixed with the upper bump stop retaining bolts. Because of the 20 degree angle of the bend, this part sits almost vertical. Part B is fixed at the top end with the rearmost indicator light fixing bolt and connects with part A at the bottom end (the slotted hole giving some degree of adjustment).



The photo shows how the bracket is fitted to the wing. Note that it also provides a convenient place to attach the wiring for the front lights.
